You must have a RIPE NCC Access account - making one is simple!

### Have a Great Idea for a Plenary Presentation?

You can submit a presentation for the RIPE Meeting Plenary.

It will be reviewed by the RIPE Programme Committee (PC).

Keep an eye out for the **Call for Presentations** - usually opens **six months before the meeting**.

Review submissions for plenary content and select speakers/presentations

Aim to provide a **dynamic plenary** that delivers what attendees want to see


"Birds of a Feather" - people with the same interests gathering to talk about a particular topic/issue




