- 2014-03
 - “Remove Multihoming Requirement for AS Number Assignments”
 - in review phase since Nov 2014
 - no consensus so far
 - * item of dispute: “max 1000 ASn per organization” clause
 - * some sort of “slow-down” mechanism is needed
 - * AGM voting item: bring back per-AS charge
 - review phase extended until after AGM decides
 - then WG chairs and proposers decide how to go on
