

# From the Annual Report 2014

Operational Highlights (end 2014):

- Continued growth: 1,216 additional members in 2014
- Member engagement: ~2,600 meeting attendees
- 112 training courses to 2,290 members
- 2,479 /22 IPv4 allocations & 1,874 IPv6 allocations
- 23% of our members have their resources certified
- More than 7,550 active RIPE Atlas probes
- 2.6 million RIPEstat users (up from 1 million in 2013)
- 32,000 Customer Service requests



# From the Annual Report 2014

Financial Overview:

- Net result of EUR 3.4 Million
- This will be placed into our reserves tax free
- Reserves are 25.3 M (119% of total expenses)
- Operational expenses were 3% lower than budgeted
- Staff numbers are 137 FTE (1 FTE over budget)
- Cost per member is still falling (2% lower than 2013)




- Maintaining a strong registry
- Conducting effective outreach and external relations throughout our service region
- Consolidating and improving our entire service offering
- Refining both our internal and external processes to provide further efficiency

- 2,500 holders of 4,700 legacy resources contacted
  - Around 700 have chosen one of the available options

- Maintain high training standards (new RIPE NCC Academy IPv6 Training Course in early June)


