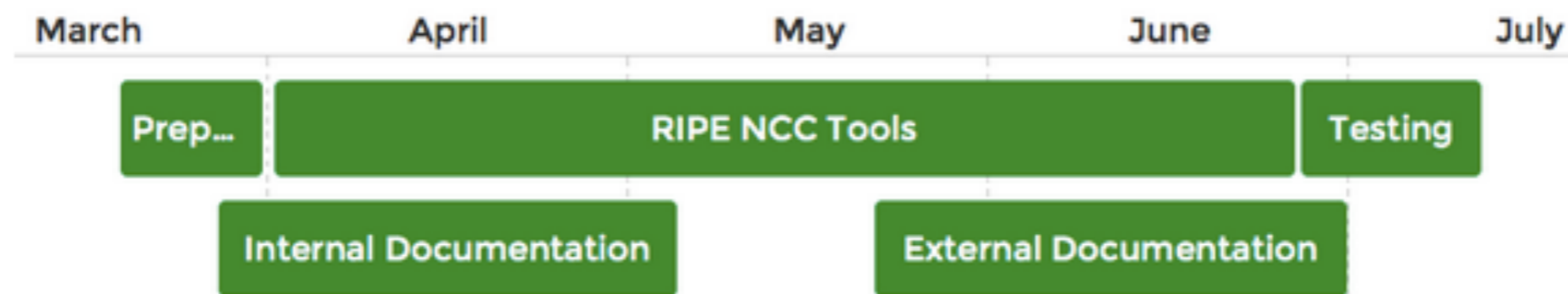
- **Accepted**

- 2014-04: “Removing IPv6 Requirement for Receiving Space from the Final /8”
- 2014-07, -08, -10, -11: “Language Clarification in RIPE Documents”
- 2014-06: “Publication of Sponsoring LIR for Legacy Internet Resource Holders”
- 2014-12: “Allow IPv6 Transfers”
- 2014-13: “Allow AS Number Transfers”
- 2014-05: “Policy for Inter-RIR Transfers of Internet Resources”

## 2014-12: Allow IPv6 Transfers and 2014-13: Allow AS Number Transfers

Implementation start: March 2015

Estimated duration: Three and a half months

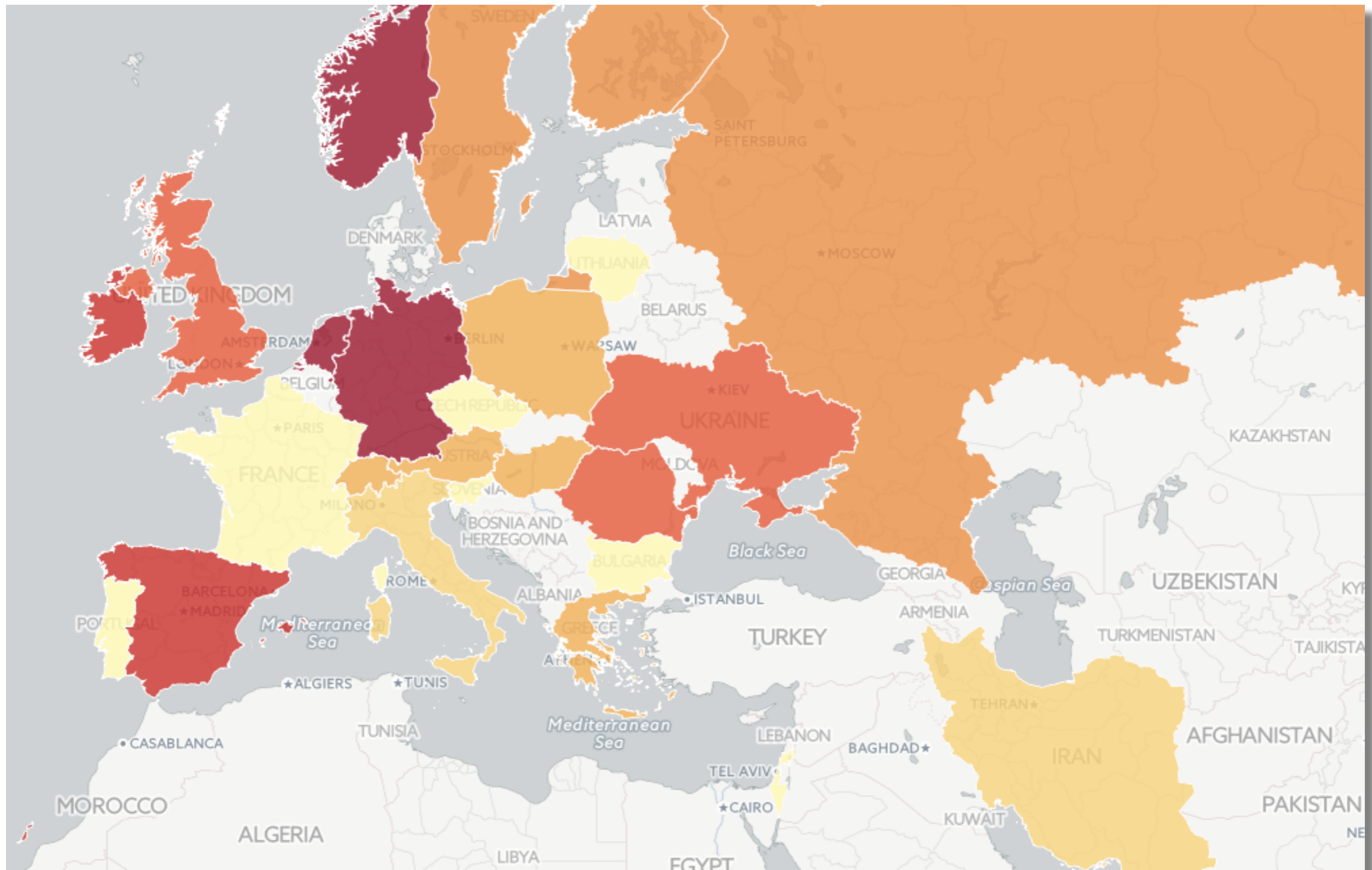
